



How can we expect any acceptable future if we refuse to look back? Retrogrades are feared because they are a chance in time to reflect on the past, what we did right, what we did wrong and what to take with us into the future. We have many chances this quarter to prove our dignity with the arrival of four whole-ass retrogrades.



The next retrograde is in Uranus. Uranus will station retrograde at 18 degrees Taurus on August 24 at 9:53am. We're also in the middle of a Saturn retrograde that began in early June that'll extend until October. All of this is set to prolong the Saturn Uranus Square I mentioned earlier.
